

## Rules & Regulations

- i. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted.
- ii. No horse or pony may compete more than once in a class.
- iii. All horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over (except in hand classes).
- iv. No entry will be accepted without the appropriate entry fee.
- v. The organiser's decision is final.
- vi. No excessive use of whips or spurs.
- vii. All objections must be made in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident to the secretary, Mrs S Adams, accompanied by a deposit of £20.00 to be returned if the objection is upheld.
- viii. Entry fees will be returned only if the event is cancelled (not if it is rescheduled due to weather or ground conditions) or entry refused, or on production of a veterinary or doctor's certificate. In the event of cancellation, £2.00 per entry will be retained to cover administration costs.
- ix. A charge of £2.00 per rider will be made to cover First Aid.
- x. Competitors are advised to contact Mrs S Adams on 07787 155435 if they consider that there is any possibility of cancellation due to weather or ground conditions.
- xi. No competitor may enter or proceed in a class if considered unfit by the medical professional in attendance.
- xii. Do not muck out horse transport in the parking area.
- xiii. No Rubbish to be left on the showground.
- xiv. Children must have adult supervision at all times.

The organisers do not hold themselves responsible for anything that might happen to competitors, onlookers or any other person, their property, stewards or horses in any connection with or arising out of these events and it shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action.

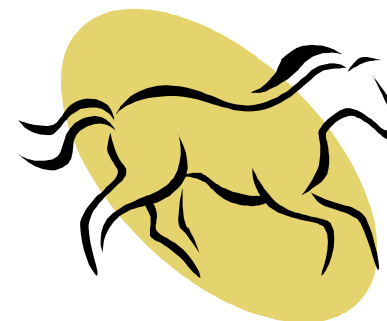
